Dr. Terry Rodenberg, Director Center for International Studies - WIU

"GLOBALIZATION"

A popular topic in today's media is the idea of globalization and its impact on the world. This presentation will take a look at the changes which have occurred in the Midwest as a result of globalization as well as some of the problems facing us in meeting these challenges. Included will be a critical assessment of the role of education and our apparent inability to meet these demands.

Terry Rodenberg is currently the Director of the Center for International Studies at Western Illinois University. He previously served as the Assistant Vice Chancellor and Director of International Affairs at East Carolina University (2005-2007) and as Professor of Sociology and Executive Director of International Studies at Central Missouri State University (1972-2005). In 1984 he was a guest professor at Vaxjo University, Vaxjo, Sweden.

A native of Davenport, Iowa, he earned degrees from William Penn College, Mankato State University, Minnesota, and the University of Kansas. In 1998 he received the Academic Leadership in International Education Award from the International Relations Council in Kansas City and in 2006 was presented the Distinguished Service Award from Central Missouri State University. Dr. Rodenberg is the founder of the 35 university consortium for teaching/studying abroad called the Middelburg Center for Transatlantic Studies in the Netherlands, which won the prestigious Andrew Heiskell Award for Innovation in International Education from the Institute of International Education in 2005. In October, 2009, in recognition of his contributions in developing the Center, "The Terry C. Rodenberg Middelburg Center for Transatlantic Studies Lecture Series" was established at the Roosevelt Academy in the Netherlands.

He has made presentations in a number of countries, including Sweden, the Netherlands, Mexico, England, Wales, Poland, Hungary, New Zealand and Australia. His most recent topics have focused upon internationalization, globalization, global educational issues and baseball history.
